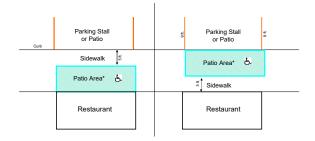
The District of Squamish permits the extension of sidewalk café patios and sidewalk sales areas onto District owned sidewalks at no cost through the traffic bylaw.

The licence agreement and a link to the traffic bylaw is available in the Real Estate Services section of the District website: squamish.ca/sidewalk

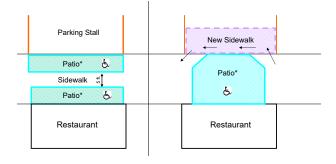
To obtain a licence for a sidewalk café, please provide two copies of a detailed site plan drawn to scale of the restaurant, the sidewalk café and the adjacent sidewalk and curb, clearly showing all exits, outside tables and chairs, bus zones, parking, landscaping and any other District street furniture to a distance of 15 feet on either side of the restaurant footage.

If the site plans are approved, a licence agreement is required between your business and the District to legitimize your occupation of the sidewalk or parking stall.

Design specifications:

- a. Must leave 1.8 metres of sidewalk for pedestrians.
- b. Must be flush and level with the sidewalk.
- c. Seating area surfaces must be non-slip and maintenance free.
- d. Guardrails are required.
- e. Must use good quality materials.
- f. Shall not impede the safe and convenient passage of pedestrians.

Sidewalk Sales



Design specifications:

- a. Must leave 1.8 metres of sidewalk for pedestrians.
- b. Products/display apparatus must not pose a hazard.
- c. Maximum height of display apparatus/ products must not be greater than 1.82 metres.
- d. Shall not block access to business doorway or neighbouring properties.
- e. Umbrellas must be securely affixed with a height of at least 2.1 metres.
- f. All amenities must be removed when the business is closed.
- g. Adjacent sidewalk must be kept in a clean/well maintained state.
- h. Must use good quality materials.
- Shall not impede the safe and convenient passage of pedestrians.

^{*}Potential area may be smaller to accommodate existing obstructions (i.e. bike racks, lampposts, planters, etc.)

General Requirements

- No fees
- No security deposit
- Businesses are required to enter and execute Licence Agreement
- Parking Stall Café Term: April 1 to October 31 each year
- Businesses are required to obtain a \$5 million insurance certificate
- Businesses are required to comply with the traffic bylaw and all of the restrictions, requirements, and Terms and Conditions of the License Agreement
