



# Squamish MHMC sample area









## Respondents by age group who reported excellent/very good general health. My Health My Community Survey, Squamish, Coastal Rural and VCH, 2013-2014





#### Respondents by household income level who reported excellent/very good general health. My Health My Community Survey, Squamish, Coastal Rural and VCH, 2013-2014





#### General health: excellent or very good. All FH/VCH Municipalities, My Health My Community Survey 2013-2014















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







#### Strong sense of belonging to local community. FH/VCH Municipalities, My Health My Community Survey 2013-2014









# Summary

- Health status is generally very good
  - Low burden of chronic disease
- Many positive lifestyle attributes
  - Exception is higher reported binge drinking
- Excellent access to primary care
- Car dependent community
  - Room to improve walking/cycling for errands/amenities
- Great elements of community resiliency
- A thriving and relatively equitable community
  - Many households with dependents under 18yrs of age




