BYLAW NO. 2432, 2016

A bylaw to amend the District of Squamish
Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2100, 2009

WHEREAS the District of Squamish deems it necessary and appropriate to amend Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2100, 2009;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Squamish, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as “District of Squamish Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2100, 2009, Amendment Bylaw (Garibaldi Springs Golf Course) No. 2432, 2016”.
2. Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2100, 2009, as amended, is further amended as follows:

By amending the designation of a portion of those parcels of land in the District of Squamish, legally described as:

Lot 4 except: Part subdivided by Plan BCP11103, Section 11 and 14,
Township 50 and District Lot 511, Group 1, New Westminster District,
Plan BCP 4573,

as shown cross hatched on the sketch attached as Schedule "A" to this bylaw, from ‘Greenway Corridors and Recreation’ designation to ‘Residential Neighbourhoods’ designation.

3. By amending the Official Community Plan Land Use map, being Schedule "B" to the District of Squamish Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2100, 2009 to reflect the land use designation.

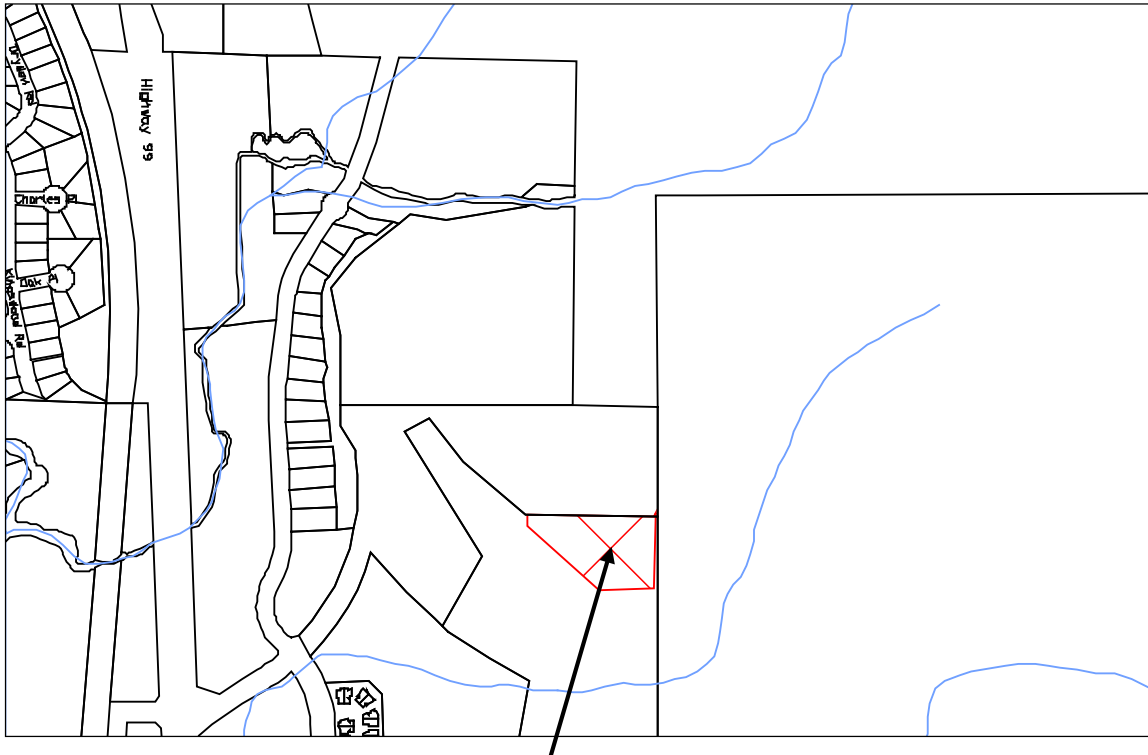
