Recent* audit results of residential garbage collection showed:

20% could be composted.

37% could be recycled through the curbside and depots

43% actually belonged in the trash.

MATERIALS TO DROP OFF AT THE QUEENS WAY RECYCLE DEPOT

What are Flexible Plastics? None of these items can go into your recycling tote, but they can easily be dropped off at the Queens Way Depot.



Plastic bags



Containers

Outer bags and product wrap



Crinkly wrappers and bags



Flexible packaging with plastic seal



Zipper lock and stand-up pouches

RICE

Woven plastic bags



Non-food protective packaging

TOTE TIPS

Coffee Cups & Lids

Keep your recyclables loose, do not bundle or bag them. Shredded paper can be contained in a separate paper bag or cardboard box within the recycling tote.

Plastic Pails, Garden

Pots, & Trays

Keep plastic bags, soft plastics, crinkly wrap, glass, and foam packaging out of the recycling tote. These materials can be recycled at depot sites in Squamish.

Empty and rinse all containers.

Flatten cardboard, remove plastic wrap from cardboard flats. Staples and tape okay.

Keep your tote locked at all times except on the morning of your collection day.

Line your kitchen catcher with newspaper or a paper bag. Wash it by hand with dish soap or in the dishwasher.

Allow grass clippings and leaves to dry before putting them into the organics tote. Use them between layers of food scraps.

Do not put compostable or biodegradable plastic bags in your organics tote. These items do belong in the garbage as they do not break down and are not recyclable.

Don't attract bears! Place your tote curbside by 7:45 a.m. on the morning of your collection day - never the night before, even if locked!
