BYLAW NO. 2266, 2013

A bylaw to amend the "District of Squamish Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 2012, 2007"

WHEREAS the District of Squamish deems it necessary and appropriate to amend "District of Squamish Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 2012, 2007, Amendment bylaw No. 2266,2013."

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Squamish, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "District of Squamish Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 2012, 2007, Amendment Bylaw No. 2266, 2013".
2. The District of Squamish Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 2266, 2013 as amended is further amended as follows:
 - (a) Part 5 Fees and Charges Schedules – By deleting "Schedule 14 – Recreation, Parks & Tourism Services" and inserting "Schedule 14 – Recreation Services".
 - (b) By deleting "Schedule 14 – Recreation, Parks & Tourism Services" and replacing it with the Schedule attached to this bylaw as "Schedule 14 – Recreation Services".
 - (c) By deleting "Schedule 17 – Squamish Seniors' Centre Hourly Rates" and replacing it with the Schedule attached to this bylaw as "Schedule 17 – Squamish Seniors' Centre Hourly Rates".

**Schedule 14 – Recreation Services
Fees and Charges Bylaw 2012, 2007
(As Amended by Bylaw No. 2266, 2013)**

(1) AGES AND GROUP DEFINITIONS

- (a) Adult - 19 to 64 years inclusive
- (b) Attendant - a person supporting a patron with a disability for the direct benefit of the patron with a disability participating in recreation service. The fee for the Attendant shall be waived.
- (c) Child - 5 to 12 years inclusive
- (d) Family - up to 2 adults and 4 children/youth
- (e) Grade 6 - a student in a Grade 6 participating educational institution with the District of Squamish and Squamish Lillooet Regional District – Area D.
- (f) Senior - 65 years and over
- (g) Student - a person who is in attendance at a recognized secondary/post-secondary institution and produces a valid student card at the time of purchase.
- (h) Tot - up to 4 years inclusive
- (i) Youth - 13 to 18 years inclusive

(2) GROUP RENTAL RATE DEFINITIONS

- (a) Adult rate is charged when over 50% of the participants is 19 years of age or older and where at least 75% of the participants reside in Squamish. Squamish Lillooet Regional District Area D residents will be considered residents of Squamish for Aquatic Centre rentals only.
- (b) Commercial/Profit rate is charged to any individual, company or organization engaged in the pursuit of business for profit through the use of the Recreation and Parks facilities.
- (c) Local Non-profit Community Group rate is charged to any local Registered Charity, local Registered Society, or local Non-profit Organization serving Squamish.
- (d) Private/Non Resident rate is charged to any individual or organization who does not reside in Squamish and does not meet the “Youth” or “Adult” or “Commercial” definitions.
- (e) School Group rate is charged to a recognized educational institution with students from kindergarten to grade 12 that includes School District 48, School District 93 and Non-profit, provincially accredited schools within the boundaries of the District of Squamish.

- (f) Youth rate is charged to a youth sporting group, club, school sport academies, and Local Non-profit Community Group when over 50% of the participants is 18 years or younger and where at least 75% of the participants reside in Squamish and whose activities are consistent with the goals, objectives and standards of the District of Squamish. Squamish Lillooet Regional District Area D youth will be considered residents of Squamish for Aquatic Centre rentals only.

(3) RENTAL/ACTIVITY AND TIME CLASSIFICATION DEFINITIONS

(a) Prime Time

Arena: Monday to Friday, 3:30 pm to 11:59 pm, Saturday, Sunday (all hours)

Aquatic Centre: Monday to Friday, 3:30 pm to 9:00 pm, Saturday, Sunday and Statutory Holidays (all hours)

Sport Fields: Monday to Friday, 3:30 pm to 9:00 pm, Saturday, Sunday (all hours)

Recreation Centre: Monday to Friday, 3:30 pm to 9:00 pm, Saturday, Sunday and Statutory Holidays (all hours)

Squamish Seniors' Centre: Monday to Friday, 3:30 pm to 9:00 pm, Saturday, Sunday and Statutory Holidays (all hours)

(b) Non-Prime Time

all other times not listed above

(4) FEE DEFINITIONS

(a) Recreation Access Pass

A program administered through Recreation Services for residents who are in financial need to access basic recreation programs at District recreation facilities at reduced cost. Eligibility requirements must be met in order to qualify for the pass.

(b) Additional Staff Recovery Fees

The additional fee charged to rentals when the rental is outside of the facility operating hours or regular service provided at that facility.

(c) Damage Deposit

The damage deposit paid to the District, prior to the rental, to be held by the District in the event of damage to the facility or equipment. The deposit is fully refundable where no damage has been assessed by staff of the District.

(5) PAYMENT OF FEES

- (a) Admission fees payment is due in advance.
- (b) Rental payment is subject to the terms of the contract in the Facility Rental Agreement.
- (c) All rental bookings contracted to the District of Squamish for the purpose of municipal business will be provided at no charge, provided facility space is available at the requested time. This does not apply to charges for additional services or equipment.

(6) COMPLIANCE WITH POLICY AND PROCEDURE

- (a) All user groups and individuals shall comply with the policies, rules and regulations governing facility usage.
- (b) Usage shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the rental agreements.
- (c) Applicants must obtain and maintain for the duration of the rental period comprehensive general liability insurance up to five million.

(7) RECREATION PROGRAMS

- (a) Standard fees and charges for all recreation program services are established on the basis that the fees from an optimum number of program registrants will offset the direct costs of the program. Direct costs are costs that would not be incurred unless the program was provided, i.e. program planning, administration, instructor, program supplies, bus rental, food, etc.
- (b) At the discretion of the Director of Recreation, special reduced rates may be implemented on a short-term basis for promotional or trial purposes.

(8) FACILITY CLASSIFICATIONS

- (a) "Arena" means the indoor Brennan Park Recreation Centre ice rink.
- (b) "Dry Floor" means the indoor Brennan Park Recreation Centre concrete. The dry floor can be rented when the arena ice is removed.
- (c) "Facility" includes Recreation and Parks' facilities including, but not limited to the Brennan Park Recreation Centre, the Squamish Seniors' Centre, sport fields, community parks and the Municipal Campground.

14.6 Cancellation and Refund Fees

Course/Camp Refund

Course Full Refund: full refund of course registration fees will be issued when a program is cancelled by Recreation Services; or a registrant withdraws at least 3 calendar days prior to the start of the first class.

Camp Full Refund: full refund of camp registration fees will be issued when registrant withdraws 5 calendar days prior to the start date of a camp. This includes, but is not limited to the following: Summer, Spring Break, Winter Holidays, Pro D Day, and LEAP Camps.

Camp No Refund: no refund will be issued if less than 5 calendar days' notice is given. Camp materials/manuals are non-refundable.

Course Partial Refund: partial refund (fee for first class deducted) of a course registration fee will be issued when a registrant withdraws from a course for any reason less than 3 calendar days prior to the start of the first class and up to the start of the second class.

Course No Refund

No credits or refunds will be issued after the start of the second class unless for medical reasons. A doctor's note may be required. Program materials/manuals are non-refundable.

Merchandise Refund: Merchandise may be returned within 14 days of purchase, if it is found to be defective. A cash register receipt is required.

Rental No Refund:

No refunds will be provided for cancellations made less than 48 hours before the start time of the rental.

Cancellations

Rental Cancellation: Are subject to the terms of the contract in the Facility Rental Agreement.

Cancellations 5 calendar days before the rental start time receive a 100% refund.

Cancellations 3 calendar days before the rental start time receive a 75% refund.

Cancellations 2 calendar days before the rental start time receive a 50% refund.

Cancellation Fee

A \$10 administration fee applies to refunds if the refund is initiated by the customer.

6. Meeting Rooms: Local Non-profit Community Group will be allowed free use of the Multi-Purpose Room for administrative meetings. The room will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis and cannot be booked more than 14 days in advance. The Seniors' Centre's Multi-Purpose Room will only be available for free during regular operating hours.			
7. Seniors Centre Society The Seniors Centre Society will be permitted 3 free prime time rentals and 6 free non-prime time rentals for use of the Multi-Purpose Room, Art Room or Great Room. The room will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.			
8. Get Active 55 Card: For \$15 per year (from the date of purchase), Squamish residents age 55 years or older may purchase the Get Active 55 Card. This membership card entitles the card holder to 10% off the card holder's program registration fees for programs at the Squamish Seniors Centre, 10% off food and beverages at the café at the Squamish Seniors Centre, 15% of rentals at the Squamish Seniors Centre, and a free membership to the Seniors Centre Society.			

9. Get Active 55 Gold Card:

For \$25 per year (from the date of purchase), Squamish residents age 55 years or older may purchase the Get Active 55 Gold Card. This membership card entitles the card holder to 10% off the card holder's program registration fees, 10% off Visit Passes (10 or 20), and 10% off Monthly Passes (1, 3, or 12 Month). In addition, this membership card entitles the card holder to an additional 5% (15% total) for program registration fees for programs at the Squamish Seniors Centre, 10% off food and beverages at the café at the Squamish Seniors Centre, 15% of rentals at the Squamish Seniors Centre, and a free membership to the Seniors Centre Society.
