- Clarification of which groups to be included in the curated list to be posted at the Seniors' Information Hub/ kiosk(s): groups that are 'open' to new members, formal status not required
- Bulletin boards, similar to the one at the library (photo provided) can be made by Men's Shed for cost, including a lock; depending on the placement of boards, locks may not be required and less sturdy/weather-tolerant models available for lower price at Walmart.
- Discussion around potential locations of the six (6) boards (see OUTCOMES)
- Discussion around the readability of The 55 calendar; recommend colour-coding to differentiate between locations of programs; differentiation between DoS and user group programs is irrelevant
- Presentation by Dave Nabi of a preliminary proposal to offer an Activity Café to the greater 55+ community in DoS-leased space at Westwinds Program Room front half. Official proposal is still in the works but some components to include:
 - 9am 2pm twice weekly (Friday and TBD)
 - 8 tables, each with an activity plus another (carpet bowling/cornhole/ping pong)
 - Use of the kitchen to stage delivered food (no food prep to take place on site)
 - To be priced low/break-even point
 - To be coordinated/facilitated by volunteers
- Discussion about Activity Café identified: a need for it to be distinct and branded separately from SSCS, a need to explore different funding models, grants, & resources, a need for a new volunteer model for recruitment
- Mandy updated on a potential new partnership with Squamish Helping Hands Society to use the kitchen
 as well as offer a seniors-oriented satellite food bank; Health Inspector is coming later this week to
 determine what is needed to be operational.
- Discussion about the need for Makers' Spaces in town for all sorts of user groups / possible fit with Squamish Arts; to be included/considered in future facilities audit
