



Declaration of Local Recovery Period ORDER

WHEREAS a State of Local Emergency was declared in relation to Dryden Creek Wildfire within the jurisdiction of District of Squamish on 06/10/2025 through:

- *Declaration of State of Local Emergency SOLE 001, 6/10/2025*
- *Extension ORDER of State of Local Emergency SOLE 001, 06/24/2025*
- *Extension ORDER of State of Local Emergency SOLE 001, 07/07/2025*

AND WHEREAS the Dryden Creek Wildfire emergency has subsided sufficiently, and it is appropriate to transition out of a State of Local Emergency;

AND WHEREAS the District of Squamish is satisfied that the use of recovery powers under Section 118 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* are required in order to recover from the emergency;

NOW THEREFORE:

I DECLARE, pursuant to Section 98 (1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, that a local recovery period exists in the area of BLOCK D SECTION 23 TOWNSHIP 50.

The following recovery powers under Section 118 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* is necessary in order to recover from the emergency:

- *Prohibit the entry into any structure or onto any land, by any person and for any purpose related to protecting the health, safety or well-being of persons, or the safety of property or of objects or sites of heritage value, for BLOCK D SECTION 23 TOWNSHIP 50.*

Per Section 100(1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, the local recovery period will remain in force for a period of 90 days or less, until the end of the day on October 15, 2025, unless amended or cancelled by District of Squamish or the Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness.
