

## Declaration of State of Local Emergency ORDER

WHEREAS there is an *active wildfire hazard* within the jurisdiction of District of Squamish;

AND WHEREAS the *wildfire* poses an existing or imminent threat to people and property within the areas known as *Brackendale, Tantalus Road and Skyridge*;

AND WHEREAS this *wildfire* emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or well-being of persons or the safety of property or objects or sites of heritage value;

NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 95 (1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* that a state of local emergency exists in *the District of Squamish* due to *Dryden Creek Wildfire* and potential *risks for the safety of the community*.

As per Section 97 (1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* the state of local emergency will remain in force for fourteen days, until *June 24, 2025 (06/24/2025)* at midnight unless cancelled by District of Squamish or the Minister responsible.
