- Update #5 Seeking to finalize Reach 5 alignment and overall adoption of coastal mitigation strategy.




# Reach 5 – Upper Mamquam Blind Channel (Hwy 99 to Smoke Bluffs)

#### **Short-listed Options:**

- 1) Highway/Foreshore Hybrid (yellow)
- 2) Highway/Logger's Lane Hybrid (green)

#### • Considerations:


- Area protected
- Cost
- Environmental impact
- Technical challenges (geotechnical, integrating with existing/future development)
- Decision has trade-offs





### Reach 5 – Recommendations

- 1) Recommended to select a preferred alignment for future planning purposes.
- 2) Recommended to leave as a 'Special Study Area'. Alignment should be confirmed during design phase.
- 3) Select Highway/Foreshore hybrid (yellow) as preferred alignment due to Council feedback on improved land use.
