






Q2 How important is it to preserve views of St'et'e7imin (Castle Rock) from Junction Park?






Q3 How important is it to preserve views of Tsewilx (Tantalus Mountain Range) from Junction Park?






Q4 How important is it to preserve views of Slhanay from Junction Park?








Q9 How important is it to preserve views of Siám Smánit (Stawamus Chief) from the intersection of Winnipeg Street and Cleveland Avenue?






Q10 How important is it to preserve views of St'et'e7imin (Castle Rock) from the intersection of Winnipeg Street and Cleveland Avenue?







How important is it to preserve views of Tsewilx (Tantalus Mountain Range) from the intersection of Cleveland Avenue and Winnipeg Street?








Q18 How important is it to preserve views of St'et'e7imin (Castle Rock) from the Mamquam Channel?












Q21 How important is it to preserve views of the Mamquam Mountains from the Mamquam Channel?






Q22 How important is it to preserve views of Smoke Bluffs from the Mamquam Channel?






Q23 How important is it to preserve views of the bluffs below Siám Smánit (Stawamus Chief) from the Mamquam Channel?




Q29 How important is it to preserve views of St'et'e7imin (Castle Rock) from the intersection of Main Street and Cleveland Avenue?






Q30 How important is it to preserve views of Tsewilx (Tantalus Mountain Range) from the intersection of Main Street and Cleveland Avenue?






Q31 How important is it to preserve views of Nakwaach (Echo Falls) from the intersection of Main Street and Cleveland Avenue?








Q49 How important is it to preserve views of Tsewilx (Tantalus Mountain Range) from the intersection of Victoria Street and Cleveland Avenue?




Q60 How important is it to preserve views of St'et'e7imin (Castle Rock) from the intersection of Winnipeg Street and Second Avenue?




