7. CRAG AND ROUTE MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Cliffs contain valuable habitat for many species of invertebrates, mosses, lichens, birds, and reptiles. Following these guidelines will help avoid excessive damage to this habitat and help ensure that rock climbing continues to be a sustainable and low impact sport.

1. *Only clean areas which will be used for climbing i.e. On or adjacent to a recognised defined route. Minimize disruption.*
2. *Don't use toxic materials or hazardous materials like bleach, that kills salmon fry, invertebrates, and amphibians.*
3. *Remove as little vegetation from cracks and ledges to preserve nesting habitat and other habitat values.*
4. *Use hand tools only. Do not use power washers, generators, or grinders etc. Power washing will permanently damage any pictographs, petroglyphs or arch values that were hidden under the vegetation.*
5. *The landowner should be informed and/or approve of any route development, route cleaning and development of new routes on District or other property.*
6. *Falling of ANY trees require authorization under municipal bylaws and under FRPA on Crown Land.*
7. *Damage to riparian areas and altering streams without authorization from the Province is prohibited by Provincial legislation.*
