SECTION 2: ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

I hereby declare that I am (all must apply):

- 18 years of age or older on October 20, 2018;
- a Canadian Citizen (Landed Immigrants and Permanent Residents are not permitted to vote);
- a resident of BC for at least the past 6 months; and,
- not disqualified by law from voting in an election.
