

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY HOURS
INFORMATION FOR
ALL BUILDING PERMIT RECIPIENTS

Please be advised that the District of Squamish's Noise Control Bylaw permits construction activity to occur between the hours of:

Monday to Friday	7:00 AM to 8:00 PM
Saturday	8:00 AM to 7:00 PM
Sunday & Statutory Holidays*	10:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Construction activity includes but is not limited to: demolition, dismantling, excavation, construction of components & materials in any form, alteration, repair, maintenance, painting, laying of pipe, equipment installation & maintenance, fueling, clean up, delivery and removal of materials & equipment, warming up of equipment, arrival and departure of contractor & trades.

Fines will be applied to sites that are found to be in contravention.

Please note that for construction activities such as large concrete pours, if you cannot complete the work within the Bylaw permitted hours, you must make an application in advance for an exemption to work outside the hours. Please contact the Engineering Department at 604-815-5012 to apply for an exemption.

*Statutory Holidays include: New Year's Day, Family Day, Good Friday, Victoria Day, Canada Day, British Columbia Day, Labour Day, Thanksgiving Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas Day, and any other holiday prescribed by Provincial Legislation.

Noise Control Construction Signs

When a permit application is received for development, a Noise Control Construction Sign is to be posted for:

- All demolition permits
- All building permits

The permit holder is to ensure the sign is posted prior to start of development and maintained during the course of demolition and construction.

The sign must be separate, highly visible and not part of any other signage. A .pdf file will be supplied by the Building Department for your convenience. The Noise Control Construction Sign must:

- a) Be posted in a prominent location on the construction site that is clearly visible from all adjacent streets and lanes;
- b) Contain both the civic address and the Building Permit number;
- c) Set out the hours permitted of construction under the Bylaw, and any exemptions to the construction hours which may have been granted;
- d) State the name of the general contractor for the construction, with the name and telephone number of an individual representative of that general contractor;
- f) Give a monitored 24 hour telephone contact number for complaints and concerns.
