SQUAMISH EDUCATION Snapshot



Education facilities include a network of primary, elementary and secondary schools, the School District No 48 (Howe Sound) School Board Offices, and post-secondary institutions. Quest University, located east of the Garibaldi Highlands, is a liberal arts school serving approximately 700 students. Capilano University maintains a campus in the District; however, at present courses are not being offered in Squamish.

The Oceanfront Peninsula Sub Area Plan includes 5.4 hectares of land dedicated to education use; these lands are intended to support a range of outdoor, environmental and fine arts programs along with a traditional post-secondary or university curriculum.


